This year we are again enjoying our Virtual Science sessions each Thursday at 10am, connecting with the Discovery Science team for engaging STEM learning. Throughout the term, students are exploring chemistry concepts such as material properties, states of matter, chemical reactions and heat through hands-on experiments and investigations.

This term the focus is chemistry and scientific investigation skills. Students have been exploring fascinating concepts such as what makes bubbles form, the properties of different materials, and how solids, liquids and gases behave. Through practical experiments they have also been investigating chemical reactions, heat, reversible and irreversible changes, and even some “kitchen chemistry” using everyday materials.
